Maudore Minerals, Ltd.

Maudore Minerals, Ltd., has the cash, the property, and the ounces. We think this junior stock pick will prove to one of the really hot movers in the forthcoming precious metals rallies. There is nothing better than Quebec in our view. The management team is absolutely superb and the Maudore resource reports tell us this one is a winner. Others think so too, from the investor-shareholder market action thus far. We recommend investors and traders enter this choice after the next profit-taking pullback during this month of October, 2009.

"Maudore Minerals Ltd. (TSX-V: MAO) owns 100% of the Comtois Gold Project and is focused on developing this resource in Quebec, Canada. Quebec is a mineral-rich, mining-friendly, politically and economically stable environment. The province rebates in cash almost 50% of mining exploration expenditures, providing Maudore with extremely cost-effective work programs. The high-grade Comtois has a NI 43-101 compliant resource report (2002) (is) estimating 524,000 ounces (inferred-uncut) - 808,000 tons at a grade of 20.2 grams per ton."

Potential Resource

"The current resource encompasses only mineralization to 200 meters depth. Recent deeper holes have successfully intersected high grade at depths of about 500, 700 and 900 meters, considerably below the 200 meter cutoff on the resource. In addition, other holes to the west have potential to increase the strike length and number of ounces by a considerable margin. A revised geological model has been confirmed by successful drilling of high grade intercepts in the area between current resource blocks, indicating the potential for a semi-continuous span of gold mineralization over a two kilometer strike length. Furthermore, there is good potential for volcanogenic massive sulphide (VMS) gold mineralization occurrences on the property.

This region of Quebec has prolific VMS mine occurrences."

Maudore Minerals Is Busy In Our Favorite Spot-Quebec, Canada.



Note the steady growth over this past year. A recent breakout rally and profit-taking event signal a bigger move in the next rally. The last rally leg is one of two for last quarter of 2009. In 2010, expect two more in first half. With gold passing 1050 to 1066 on the futures, we forecast faster bull markets.

Five Year Weekly Maudore Mineral Chart Signals Steady Up-Trend.



Maudore has approximately 21 million shares fully diluted, with 70% held by insiders and institutions. Financially, the company has more than sufficient funds to operate at the present drilling rate for the entire year of 2010.

Maudore Minerals Project Program

"Maudore Minerals is aggressively exploring the Comtois Project area. Two rigs are currently active; one is drilling beside and below the resource for expansion potential. New claims were acquired by Maudore recently which greatly expanded the size of the project area, up to 95 kilometers westward. The potential for VMS gold

mineralization in the area has created a second exploration model, and the second rig is currently conducting a short drill-exploration program on qualified VMS targets before returning to the main Comtois Project.”

Key Data Points On The Comtois Drilling Program

1. The presence of some near surface mineralization at these high grades.
2. The main road crosses the property between the Bell and Osborne,
3. The James Bay power project to the North, providing Québec with North America's lowest-cost power. has a transmission line less than 3 kilometers away,
4. Lebel-sur-Quévillion and the relatively nearby towns of Rouyn-Noranda and Val d'Or have experienced mining personnel. These factors, along with high grades, argue for an ultimately low cost operation.

”The Comtois resource is part of the prolific Abitibi Greenstone Belt, 15 kilometers from Lebel-sur-Quévillion. The property comprises 50,000 hectares or about 300 square kilometers. Sulphide-rich mineralization occurs within volcanics. Maudore has defined three main gold zones in the Osborne section of the deposit and four in the Bell, all are still open in all directions. The Osborne has been traced by drilling over a 1.7 kilometer length to a 400 meter depth and the Bell, ½ kilometer and 200 meters respectively. Inferred resources total 808,000 tons with a 9.6 gram average cut-off grade, 3.7 meter average thickness encompassing 249,000 ounces with a 6 gram gold cutoff (based very conservatively on \$300/oz.). Without cutting, the resource contains 524,000 ounces of gold at an average grade of 20.2 grams/ton.”

Maudore Minerals

The company is listed on the Toronto Venture Exchange (TSXV) (CA:MAO) and has 19,010,000 share outstanding. The market cap is 62.7 million. The 52 week high was C\$3.70 on Tuesday, October 6, 2009 and the 52 week low was on Monday, October 27, 2008. The average share price on the 50 day moving average was C\$2.46 and C\$1.97 on the 200 day average. Volumes were 33,600 on the 50 day and 23,000 on the 200 day.

Junior miners tend to follow gold and silver prices rather closely. Normally, the larger operating senior miners have similar moves but the percentage of movement in senior share prices is much smaller. This has to do with market cap, volumes, and exchange platform selections.

Investors and traders buy the junior shares, who are primarily explorers, for the faster movement and response to precious metals prices. *From last month in September to this middle of October, 2009, CA: MAO rallied from just over C\$2.00 to C\$3.50. This is super move in just a few days for any junior.*

We attribute this excellent fall 2009 rally to several things:

- (1) The company has the correct and very attractive key ingredients for a quality junior miner. Those being management, cash, reserve resources and attractive geography along with outstanding background politics based in Quebec.
- (2) Of course on the fundamentals, the past few weeks have been offering superior gains in cash prices of gold and silver along with other commodities, too.
- (3) Next, the US Dollar is severely over-printed and diluted. This forces all commodities prices higher.
- (4) Further, the world-dominating US Government policies, both domestic and foreign discourage traditional investments in shares and bonds due to basic economics and tax policies. Precious metals then shine.
- (5) Compare that negative with the fact Quebec not only encourages professional mining but bends over backwards to welcome exploration and senior mining companies, properly operated.

(6) Quebec is serious about jobs and job creation in the mining industry and is geographically blessed with legendary ore reserves. Along with good roads, rail, inexpensive grid, water and ocean shipping, they have it all. This presents a win-win-win for the province, the mining companies and the employees.

This is a new recommendation from *Trader Tracks Newsletter*. We have been sifting ideas from over 200 junior exploration companies and have reduced our selections to the top 20-25 we feel have the best chance of delivering as promised while receiving an excellent reception in the markets. Watch for an opening price entry recommendation on Maudore later this month after the current normal stock market profit-taking correction. Usually, November 1 plus or minus a few days is the fall bull cycle beginning. This lasts until spring of 2010 with a minimum of one normal correction in February. We like the company, its prospects and the share price. They have a great start and should find a corrected base at C\$2.50 to C\$3.00 with new rallies to C\$5.00+ per share by April, 2010 on our forecasts.
